**Job Description**

**ROLE AND RESPONSIBILITIES**

Provide customers with one empty carrier at a time (Children receive a green quart container to pick into if they would like) and ask them to fill out a contact form.

We also ask customers to write their name on a label to be placed on the outside of the carrier. You may offer customers an additional carrier if you notice their current one is getting close to full and make sure they write their names on ALL carriers.

Escort customers with their empty carriers out to the field and show them where to begin picking, in the first available rows/starting location at the row marker. Try to keep groups and couples together as much as possible, even if it means starting a new section of rows. Children should pick ahead and parents follow.

Instruct customers which direction they will be going and to pick ALL the ripe fruit on both sides of the aisle they are in. They are to pick to the middle of the row on each side and alert them to the fact that plenty of berries are hidden under the leaves in the middle of the rows.

Once you notice customers are done picking, you must mark the stop with a yellow field marker.

Be friendly, polite and talk with customers, offer help in any way you can. Always offer to help carry strawberries from the field to the checkout and also offer help from the checkout to their vehicles. Be careful when handling full boxes of berries so that you are not dropping them on the ground.

Good communication with other workers in the shed and/or in the field as well as the supervisor(s) is a must. Please treat this business as if it were your own, if you see garbage, dispose of it, if you see a problem in the field, alert your management team, if you see thistles or weeds in the field, pull them out with a glove and properly dispose of them. You are responsible for using the time clock to check in before and at the end of each shift. If you do not, you will not get paid. Paychecks will be distributed at the end of the season due to the short timeframe.
